2. Trail crew leaders will direct you to a bus that will go to work areas. Please feel free to eat your sack breakfast on bus.
3. The buses will take you to your project area. (Most groups will be bussed to various Conejo locations and returned by 12:00 p.m.)

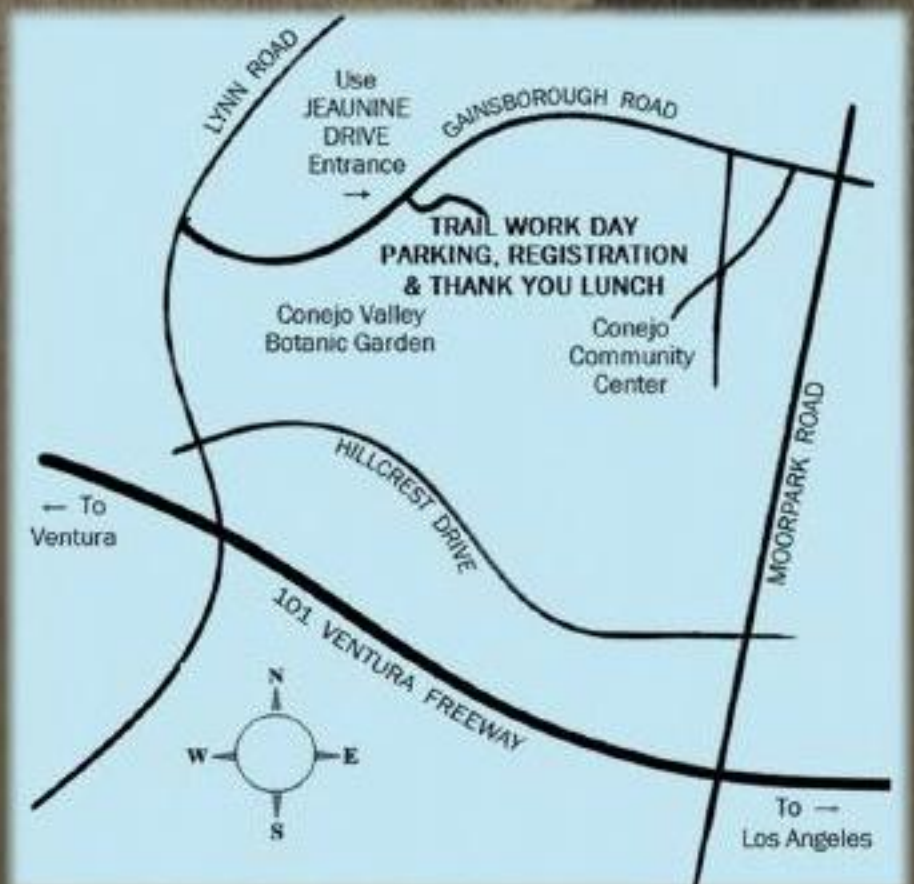
You must be present at the drawing to win.

Water will be available at the sign-in area so be sure to bring a water bottle and fill up before you get on the bus. Toilets will be at Conejo Community Park only and not at the work sites so please use the facilities before you are bussed to your project area.

Wear protective clothing, sturdy shoes, **GLOVES**, hat and sunscreen. If you have some loppers or hand tools, please bring them. (Be sure to put your I.D. on any tools you bring as we will not be responsible for lost tools.)

Beware of poison oak, ticks and rattlesnakes. Check with a ranger or trail crew leader if you need assistance with identification.

Follow the directions of the ranger and trail crew leaders at all times, they are trained for trail projects. If you or someone in your work group needs medical attention, contact a ranger or your trail crew leader.
