**Registration & bus loading 7:30 - 8:00 a.m.**

1. Check-in at registration table:
  - a. Complete and sign Liability Release form.
  - b. Receive breakfast bag and board bus.

**Work Parties - 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m.**

2. Trail crew leaders will direct you to a bus that will go to work areas. Please feel free to eat your sack breakfast on bus.
3. The buses will take you to your project area. (Most groups will be bussed to various Conejo locations and returned by 12:00 p.m.)

**Thank-you Barbecue - 12:00 - 2:00 p.m.** Mountain Bike giveaway & door prizes will be given to lucky participants at the FREE barbecue (you must be present to win, one prize per person).

Water will be available at the sign-in area so be sure to bring a water bottle and fill up before you get on the bus. Toilets will be at Conejo Community Park only and not at the work sites so please use the facilities before you are bussed to your project area.

Wear protective clothing, sturdy shoes, **GLOVES**, hat and sunscreen. If you have some loppers or hand tools, please bring them. (Be sure to put your identification on any tools you bring as we will not be responsible for lost tools.)

**Beware of poison oak, ticks and rattlesnakes.** Check with a ranger or trail crew leader if you need assistance with identification.

Follow the directions of the park ranger and trail crew leaders at all times, they are trained for trail projects. If you or someone in your work group needs medical attention, contact a ranger or your trail crew leader.
